## • Cookies Policy

- A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive and helps analyse web traffic, or lets you know when you visit a particular site.
- ePressPack uses traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to visitor needs. ePressPack only uses this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system. WordPress, which is used by ePressPack, may also use cookies when you comment on a blog post to identify you on return visits. ePressPack does not use this information for any other reason.
- Overall, cookies help ePressPack provide you with a better website, by enabling ePressPack to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives ePressPack access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.
- Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.
